That a provision of \$10,000.00 be included in the 2010/2011 Budget to retain consultants to undertake a Land Development Strategy incorporating a needs analysis, order of priority and development costs for land identified in the body of this report.

A draft report has been prepared (Attachment 10.1A). A copy of the minute of Council appends (Attachment 10.1B).

#### Comment

The plan is a compilation of the outline development plans prepared by the Consultant (PlanWest) and the Administration and reflects the views of those persons only. Council input is sought.

If public consultation is sought specific groups including real estate agents, utility providers views should be actively acquired.

#### **Statutory/Policy Implications**

There are currently no statutory provisions which require the preparation of a urban development guide plan. Once complete the document should forma component of Council's future community plan
