# SELECTION CRITERIA

2024/25 ERIC HIND SCHOLARSHIP



1. Applicant must be a resident of Merredin Shire or a performing arts student in Merredin.  
Note – applicants attending boarding school who have previously attended Merredin College or St Mary's Primary School are also eligible to apply.
2. Previous winners are ineligible.
3. Applicant must be at least 7 years of age and under 20 years of age.
4. Applicant must have studied their chosen performing arts for at least 12 months.
5. Applicant will be required to perform their chosen performing art at the interview.
6. If no suitable candidates apply, Council may contribute the funds to the local schools in the district.
7. Part scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
8. Applicant must state what the scholarship money will be expended on.
9. Should the contribution be distributed to the selected schools, a feedback report may be required to Council.
10. Scholarship money will be issued in two six monthly instalments, unless the successful applicant shows good reason to receive the full amount up front, i.e., purchase of musical instrument.
11. After six months, the successful applicant/s will be required to report to Council on the status of their progress, if applicable.
12. At the completion of twelve months, the successful applicant/s will be required to report to Council stating where the scholarship money was expended.
