



SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be a resident of Merredin Shire or a student of music in Merredin.
Note – applicants attending boarding school who have previously gone to Merredin College or St Mary’s Primary School are also eligible to apply.
2. Previous winners are ineligible.
3. Applicants must be at least 11 years of age and under 20 years of age.
4. Applicants must have studied music for at least two years.
5. Applicants will be required to perform a short piece of music at the interview.
6. If no suitable candidates apply then the scholarship will not be awarded.
7. Half scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
8. Applicants must state what the scholarship will be expended on.
9. The scholarship will be issued in two six monthly instalments of \$500 unless the successful applicant demonstrates good reason to receive the full amount, i.e. purchase of musical instrument.
10. After six months the successful applicant will be required to report to Council on the status of their study, along with a short report from their music teacher.
11. At the completion of twelve months the successful applicant will be required to report to Council stating where the scholarship money was expended.
